### 2020 Objectives for this Ministry:

- Post Council Minutes on website and in church after approval, but before next council meeting.
- Secure at least twenty new members to St. Matthew church and deter departure of existing members.
- Advertise and publicize St. Matthews community, fund raising events and special church services to exceed 2019 fund raising totals.

### Team Accomplishments Since Last Report (accomplishments since March 8, 2020):

#### **Done in Area of Communication:**

- Susan posted announcements on church cork bulletin board for "Handshake Free Zone" flyer, a flyer for
  "Safe Alternatives to Handshakes". Also mounted on this bulletin board was a "Thank You" flyer to all
  donors for newspaper ad. Susan updated Parish Council minutes and March Ministry reports replacing
  the previous reports in "Minutes" folder on cork bulletin board.
- Susan removed the 18 x 20" "Holy Week" posters from church doors (two posters, one at each entrance).
- Susan uploaded March Council minutes to website, and all Ministry Reports for March to new website page.
- Angelica sent an email "blast" (flyer) notice
  - o On March 14<sup>th</sup> regarding cancellation of March 15<sup>th</sup> church services,
  - On March 20 announcing video recording available online for March 22<sup>nd</sup> services, cancellation of "The Great American Write-In" and "Unity Sunday". Announcement of new "Giving" alternatives mentioned.
  - On March 22<sup>nd</sup> inviting members to view Sunday Mass recording and providing "readings" (chapter and verse numbers) for the service. Email also provided links to website recording and Facebook
  - o On March 17<sup>th</sup> to distribute Bishop Peter's letter.
  - On March 29<sup>th</sup> to provide readings for fifth Sunday of Lent, links to YouTube and Facebook Sunday mass recordings, listing of Facebook community opportunities, and "Options for Giving".
  - On April 4<sup>th</sup> to announce three different ways to participate in Palm Sunday service, links for those services and other "virtual" church events (Rosary, Bible Study), and "Options for Giving".
  - On April 9<sup>th</sup> to announce Easter Triduum Liturgies to be available on website and Facebook
  - o On April 10<sup>th</sup> to announce Stations of Cross service available on website and Facebook
  - On April 11<sup>th</sup> to account Easter Sunday Liturgy available on website and Facebook
- Stephany translated English language to Spanish for a thank you flyer Susan prepared. Flyer announced services online services (in both English and Spanish) on the "church closure" sign. Flyers were posted both church entrances, and office door.

 Susan built a step-by-step guide for accessing Zoom software and setting-up an account. Guide was posted on Facebook.

#### Done in Area of Advertising:

Susan notified all donors for Easter newspaper ad that the ad would not be published due to closures. All
funds were submitted to Kathryn for deposit and allocation in designated account for newspaper
advertising.

#### Done in Area of Public Relations / Membership:

- Supply of tri-fold brochures/pamphlets delivered to Kathryn at church office from the printing company.
- Stephanie completed work on translating the pamphlet (tri-fold brochure) English version to Spanish and submitted her work to Fr Arturo.
- Susan created "Visitor Welcome" contact info cards and presented the idea to Parish Council members on March 10. Rosa Isela Lopez created a Spanish version.

#### Done in Area of Website:

- Justin updated "Giving" webpage adding code/changes necessary so members can submit donations via debit or credit card, one donation at a time. Website validates information entered, transmits the amount directly to Saint Matthew Chase bank account, and sends the contributor a confirmation email.
- Justin added the AmazonSmile notice on the Giving page with information on how to get started.
- Justin added a banner that is displayed on several website pages to alert viewers to cancellations and providing instructions on where to find future notifications.
- Justin added saint-matthew.org URL to Mailchimp (email marketing service) so when email blasts are sent, the "sender" shows <u>info@saint-matthew.org</u>, instead of <u>st.matthew@gmail.com</u>. This change will improve the readership by directing emails to recipient's inbox, instead of spam or junk folders.
- Justin fixed webpage display problem in which WordPress error messages were displayed on the "Media" webpage.
- Justin sent logo animation and fonts to Matthew Hickman so videos can be better branded.
- Justin added optional "note" field to online donation "Giving" page

#### Done in Area of Facebook / Instagram:

- Stephany created a Spanish / English flyer with Saint Matthew icon to announce virtual Sunday services on Facebook and Instagram.
- Angelica added message from Deacon Tony and letter from Mother Diane on April 9<sup>th</sup> to website and Facebook post
- Stephany posted "Easter Blessings to all..." message in English and Spanish on Facebook

#### Done in Area of Other / Project Management:

- Angelica set up a CPRM project in this internet-based project management tool, created tasks and defined resources (team). Sent emails to team members with links to the CPRM Asana team site, tutorial, and Asana Overview Video.
- Angelica defined a "workflow" (end-to-end process) for coordinating with Clergy, staff, Parish Council to complete CPRM work. Information saved in Asana as a 'task".
- Bob Morano, Parish Council moderator, sent email on April 3<sup>rd</sup> to Father Arturo Querijero, Tony Russo, Diane Smith, Tammy Fuqua, and Peter Hickman requesting that they coordinate their communication needs through the Parish Council and appropriate ministry.


• Susan sent email to Parish Deacons and Clergy Council on April 6<sup>th</sup> asking that all requests for CPRM work be given appropriate "lead time", that details be accurate and complete, and event be validated.

### Activities / Work Planned / Work in Progress:

- Initiation of new website for "divorced Catholics" (Begun by Angelica Tronco)
- Addition of code in the "Giving" website page to facilitate "Recurring Payments" as donations.
- Arrangement with nearby Dollar Store management for an ad on back page of our bulletin in exchange for merchandise (paper towels, TP, hand soap, etc.) Work in progress by Sharon Smith.
- Addition of two more sandwich boards Work in progress by Sharon Smith
- Next "Saint Matt's After Dark" event - Richard Smith Group, Hispanic salsa group (to be named), or Matthew Hickman's group. Discussed preliminary interviews with UTube video of music before booking
- Advertising for Saint Matthew's T-Shirt Sale (need update from Social Justice/Outreach ministry). Justin
  mentioned that T-Shirts could be sold using our website page. Advertising opportunities for CPRM
- Website additions - "landing page" for Ordination of women & LGBTQ. *Tonya to arrange meeting with Justin for WordPress intro instructions; and may begin work on new website page.*
- Announcements / Notifications to continue on Facebook, website, email "blasts" as long as coronavirus closures in place.


Right: Enlarged version LA Times Easter ad Below: Orange County Easter ad followed by Facebook and Instagram Notice


