Done in Area of Communication:



A healing service for our founder and pastor, Bishop Peter Hickman, will be held via Zoom on November 19 at 7pm PST, led by Fr Victor Ray.



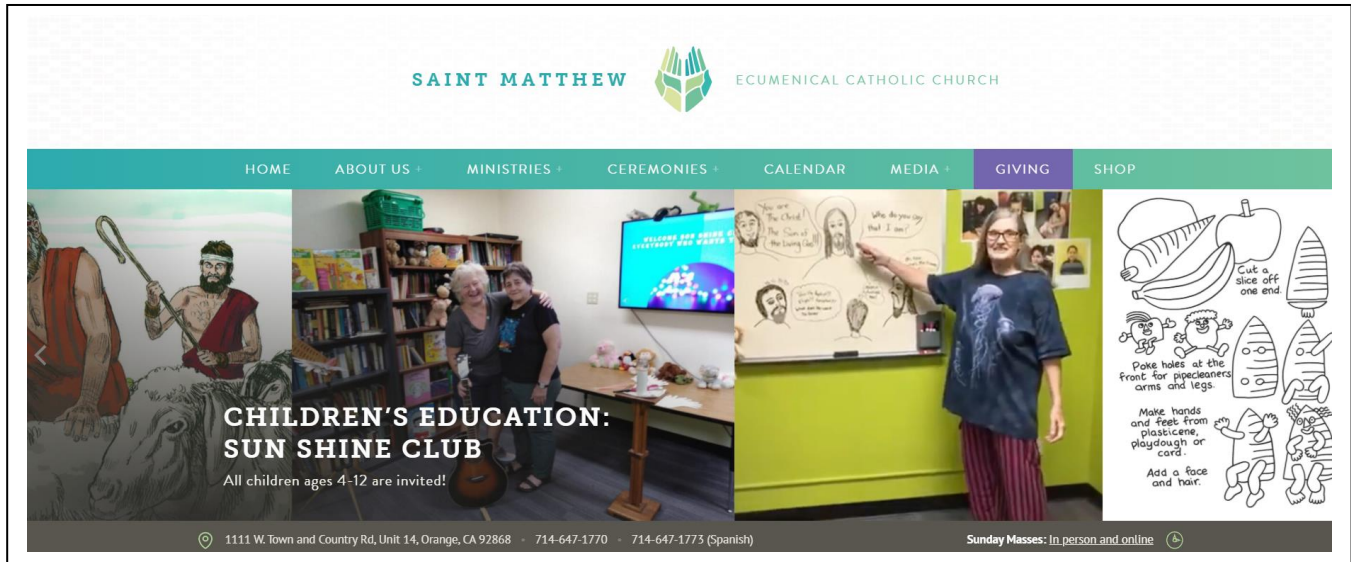

Mother Jetty Van Den Berghe
Mother and Director of Religious Children's Education




Rev. Mother Jetty Van Den Berghe was ordained a Deacon in 2013 in Europe but has been involved at Saint Matthew from 2011 and ordained a Priest at Saint Matthew in 2014. Prior, Mother Jetty was first a member of ECC in Europe where she established a parish called House of Ruth, in Sint Niklaas, Belgium in 2012. Mother Jetty continues to serve House of Ruth in Belgium via weekly skype sessions for Mass and spiritual studies. At Saint Matthew, for the past four years, she has overseen the Children's Ministry including weekly classes for ages 4-12. Some responsibilities include compiling the weekly Liturgy for Mass, scheduling of presiders, deacons, homilists, as well as actively involved in pastoral visitations, spiritual counseling and administration of the Church's website and facebook page and co-moderator of the Clergy Council. For fifteen years, she was involved in ministry in the Pentecostal Church in Belgium and pastoral counseling. Mother Jetty's training for the diaconate and priesthood was accomplished over several years through self-study, mentoring, and supervised training/experience from several ECC priests. She has joined the choir at Saint Matthew and being a retreat leader, musician, engaging in pastoral care, grief counseling, and hospitality are central to her pastoral call.

My ministry includes chairing the Liturgy Ministry Team, preparing the Presider's book for the Mass each Sunday, teaching Bible Study with Bishop Peter, and doing grief counseling as part of the Bereavement Ministry. I am also the administrator of the three year Diaconal Studies Program for St. Cyprian School of Theology. Our new deacons were all participants in this clergy formation program. Mother Esther looks forward to continuing in these ministries. My educational background, including theological and pastoral training includes: B.A. in philosophy from Cal-State, Fullerton, Ph. D. in philosophy from Claremont Graduate University, M. Div. from the Church Divinity School of the Pacific (the Episcopal Church seminary in Berkeley, CA). I also served as a hospital chaplain while completing two quarters of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE), first quarter at the Veteran's Administration Hospital, Martinez, CA; second quarter at Loma Linda University Medical Center in Loma Linda, CA. I am also a retired college dean. Before moving into the role of a college administrator I taught philosophy and comparative religion to college students for many years.
